RESPONSIBILITIES AND EXPECTATIONS:

1. Pack carefully and use a checklist. Remembering everything is not an accident – it is an intentional act. Be certain to have all your items.
2. Be helpful and offer assistance when possible.
3. Allow extra time to get from point A to B. Hotels are not designed for quick in and out access. Elevators are slow. Use the stairs when possible and NEVER ALLOW YOURSELF TO BE LATE – EVER!
4. When moving a large group such as the GWB, it is important for all members to understand that we must move swiftly, be flexible at all times, and have an endless supply of patience. It can often feel like we are hurrying to get there so we can wait. It can also feel as if we are waiting for a long time then suddenly we must move very quickly. This is the nature of moving a large group and also being a part of an event with multiple parts. Keep a positive attitude and don't allow frustration to set in.
5. Observe all laws, the Baylor Code of Student Conduct, and the Baylor travel guidelines (see attached page). NO ONE is allowed to smoke, abuse drugs, or consume alcohol at any time during this trip. You are a part of a University sanctioned event.
6. We are guests so act appropriately. At the hotel, do not wander the halls or be loud. There are other guests at our hotel.
7. As per norm, absolutely no profanity.
8. Always travel in groups (3 or more) when going out and especially at night.
9. Make certain all members are awake in the morning, don't let them miss anything.
10. Use a checklist – You must have everything. We must appear in exact uniform without deviation – This is a highly visible and important sequence of events for Baylor University and the Golden Wave Band. ***Not having everything such as your music, gloves, spats, ballcap, etc. may result in your omission from the performances, placing everyone in jeopardy.***

ALWAYS REMEMBER...

We are traveling to the Holiday Bowl as members of the largest and most visible student group in the Baylor University family. Unlike when we travel as private citizens, our appearance, words, and actions represent and reflect upon the hundreds of thousands of people associated with our band program, the University, and the state. It is the responsibility of each and every one of us to make certain that everything we do and say reflects positively on these entities while maintaining the tradition of excellence expected of us.



Golden Wave Band • Travel Guidelines

Conduct: Students representing Baylor University should conduct themselves in accordance with the General Expectations for Baylor Students, which states:

“. . . It is expected that each Baylor student will conduct himself or herself in accordance with Christian principles as commonly perceived by Texas Baptists. Personal misconduct either on or off the campus by anyone connected with Baylor detracts from the Christian witness Baylor strives to present to the world and hinders full accomplishment of the mission of the University . . . While attending Baylor, a student is expected to obey the laws of the United States, the State of Texas, and municipalities, or, if studying abroad, the laws of other countries.”

Students are at all times accountable for their conduct as representatives of the University while attending conferences, tours, or athletic events such as bowl trips or tournaments.

Alcohol/Illegal Substances: It is a violation of University policy for anyone to possess, use, or be under the influence of an alcoholic beverage (in all forms), illegal substances, or legal substances with non-prescribed intentions while on campus or attending a University-related activity off campus. This includes performances during conferences, tours, or athletic events such as bowl trips or tournaments. Any student participant violating these policies is subject to disciplinary action through the Judicial Affairs office as well as the University Bands.

Safety and Accountability: Students representing Baylor University under the supervision of a university faculty member, coach, advisor, or other university representative must abide by all guidelines set by their specific supervisor. Students' travel and lodging will be set up by the university and provided for according to university guidelines and policies. Students should not travel apart from the group unless their university supervisor grants specific approval. All special exceptions to travel apart from the group must be approved before the trip with documentation of the request and approval. When out of town, students must be accessible by cell phone and should not separate themselves from the group they are with. The faculty member, coach, advisor, or university representative should be aware of the students' whereabouts at all times.

Documentation: Each student must have documentation of insurance, a list of medical issues or allergies, and the names and phone numbers of people to contact in the unfortunate event of a medical emergency. The university supervisor shall keep a copy of this information readily available.
